PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Monthly tuition is due on the first of each month. **A late fee of \$20.00 will be charged if tuition is not received by the 5th of the month.**

The above policy is strictly enforced. If tuition is not paid within the time allowed, your child will not be permitted to attend the aftercare program until the outstanding tuition balance is paid.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- There will be a \$25.00 service charge for all checks returned by your bank.
- A two-week notice is required if you should decide to withdraw your child.
- All fees are nonrefundable.
- There is a 10% discount off the lowest tuition rate for siblings.
- School Readiness Voucher holders will be charged the difference between the aftercare's tuition rates and ELC's reimbursement to the program.
